The Pueblo Domestic Violence Community Task Force, Inc. and the YWCA of Pueblo will present their Historical Ghost Walk through the Historic Union Avenue District on September 27th & 28th, October 4th and 5th. Walking tours leave every 15 minutes from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m. starting at El Pueblo History Museum. This event is a storytelling of Pueblo's past. In case of bad weather, the event will move indoors.

New stories for this year's Ghost Walk include: Andrew McClelland and his Mummies, The Walter Brewing Company, Luis Tikas and the Ludlow Massacre as well as Pueblo's First Ladies. There will be a total of ten (10) vignettes presented throughout the heart of the district.

The Ghost Walk is a fundraising event for the aforementioned non-profit organizations. Funds raised for the Domestic Violence Task Force will go to help provide training for those who work with victims and for anti-violence education, training and advertising in the community. Funds raised for the YWCA will be used to provide shelter and counseling for women and children experiencing domestic violence and homelessness.

The cost for tickets is \$8.00 and children ages five and younger are admitted free when accompanied by an adult. Advance tickets may be purchased at the YWCA, 801 N.
